The European school network „JEM! – Joint Environmental Management according to EMAS“ invites you to participate in a European school competition.

The Motto

Our road to an eco-friendly school

Who can participate?

The competition is targeted towards pupils at the age between 14 and 19 years. Both individuals and small groups or classes can participate.

What to do?

You can submit a contribution in English or German (conception, report, documentation, model or other) about a current or concluded project. Long-term projects, which have already reached presentable results, can also be submitted before the project's conclusion.

Evaluation/award:

The evaluation will be carried out by an independent jury according to the following criteria:

- Content and representation of the work in written form
(photo documentation, video, CD-ROM and the like for the illustration of texts are highly appreciated)
- Innovation and self-initiative
- Sustainability and practical use
- Public impact, multiplier effect

The projects will be presented and awarded during a conference of the European school network JEM! in November 2006 in Vienna. The jury decides on the awarding of the prizes.

The awards

The winners will be invited to Vienna to a three-day meeting in November 2006, where they will be trained in a two-day event together with the other European school

representatives to become environmental auditors. In addition, the pupils will get the opportunity to get to know both Vienna and the winners of the other European schools. Furthermore, appreciative awards and certificates of participation will be assigned.

When is the closing date?

The contributions are to be presented by October 4th 2006.
