

Non-local Student Scholarships

Opportunities for Studying in Hong Kong

🎓 The Scholarships

- **Full Scholarship** (covering tuition, hostel and partial academic and living expenses), **Tuition Scholarship** or **Half-tuition Scholarship** per academic year for each awardee.
- Renewable on an annual basis and tenable for a period of up to the normative duration of study, subject to continued outstanding academic performance.

🏛️ Curriculum

The University has adopted broad-based admission to study programmes in Business and Social Sciences Faculties. In addition to the current Bachelor of Business Administration (Hons) (BBA) programme, starting from the 2016-17 intake, a distinct BBA - Risk and Insurance Management will be offered. The Faculty of Arts will implement a hybrid admission model such that programme-based admission will be adopted in parallel with the current broad-based admission. Non-local applicants will be considered for admission to the four-year curriculum on individual basis, subject to the availability of places.

[#] Students admitted via broad-based admission will be asked to rank the majors/streams in order of preference and be allocated to the majors/streams after admission. Please refer to www.LN.edu.hk/admissions/ug/overseas/progs.php for major/stream allocation criteria.

📎 Eligibility

- Non-local applicants (other than Hong Kong and the Chinese Mainland citizens) are persons entering Hong Kong for the purpose of education with a student visa/entry permit issued by the Director of Immigration of the HKSAR Government.
- Non-local applicants should have attained at a recognised post-secondary institution outside Hong Kong an equivalent qualification as stipulated below:
 - ✎ a degree or a sub-degree awarded by a recognised post-secondary institution; or
 - ✎ an International Baccalaureate Diploma; or
 - ✎ High School Diploma plus a minimum of 1650 on SAT I; or
 - ✎ satisfactory completion of the first year in an undergraduate curriculum or the first year of a sub-degree programme of a recognised post-secondary institution; or
 - ✎ other equivalent qualifications* which the University will consider on a case-by-case basis.
- Non-local applicants may be required to achieve one of the following English language requirements:
 - ✎ a minimum of Grade C in English in the GCE O-Level or GCSE Examination or an equivalent public examination; or
 - ✎ Grade 4 or above in International Baccalaureate English Language; or
 - ✎ a TOEFL score of 213 in the computer-based test, or 550 in the paper-based test, or 79 in the internet-based test; or
 - ✎ an IELTS overall band score of 6.0.
